

Dear Parents,

McCallie is pleased to partner with A.W.G. Dewar to offer a Tuition Refund Plan (TRP). The TRP can help offset your financial obligations to McCallie in the event that your son must withdraw or is dismissed. No deduction or remission of tuition shall be made by the School for any absence, dismissal or withdrawal for disciplinary, health, academic, personal or other reasons whatsoever including School closure in the event of a disaster or pandemic. Without the TRP, parents or legal guardians are responsible for the entire balance of the annual tuition.

If your son must withdraw for medical reasons, the plan will pay 80% (See non-qualifying reasons listed in the brochure for details) of the unused yearly insured fees, provided the student's injury/illness forces the student to withdraw from school for 31 or more consecutive days.

Should your son withdraw for non-medical reasons, or a dismissal occur, the Plan will pay 50% of the unused yearly insured fees provided the student has withdrawn from school after attending more than fourteen consecutive calendar days beginning with the student's first class day of attendance in the academic year. The cost of the TRP is 1.65% of the cost of tuition less any financial aid awarded. The premiums for the 2021-2022 school year are as follows:

Day Students:	\$30,640	\$538.20
Boarding Students:	\$58,350	\$1024.92
International Students:	\$62,600	\$1101.42

TRP coverage is required for all 1st time boarders, and all international families, unless you opted to pay 100% prior to the start of school. You **must** indicate on the enrollment contract whether you do, or do not, wish to participate in the plan. The charge for TRP premium will appear on your August billing statement through your FACTS account. If you selected to enroll in the plan and later feel that it is not necessary, you must contact student billing via email to request a cancelation of coverage no later than August 5th.
